SUBMISSION PROCESS

We will be handling the manuscript processing through the Cambridge University Press recommended online system ScholarOne hosted by Manuscript Central.

- 1. Please visit the ScholarOne homepage at: https://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/iau. Create an account by clicking on the "Create Account" tab on the top left.
- 2. Log in to your account using your credentials and click on the "Author" tab on the top left.
- 3. First review the instructions by clicking on the tab "Instructions and Forms" on the top right of the page. We request that you use the latex template and class files available therein to prepare your manuscript. If you use word doc then upload a converted pdf and the original doc file in the last step.

- 5. Under the Author tab in the Start New Submission section, click on the tab "Begin Submission".
- 6. In the new page that appears, you have to select the tab "Living around Active Stars" listed under the section "Type".
- 7. Follow the instructions in the pages that appear subsequently to provide essential details about your manuscript (title, abstract, authors and affiliations) and upload your manuscript files. Upload the generated final manuscript file in PDF format as well as the manuscript latex and figure files and other latex style or class files that you might have used to compile your manuscript. However, we request that you minimize the usage of non-IAU style or class files to ensure smooth processing.
